OREGON HFMA STANDARDS OF CONDUCT

(Updated July, 2009)

Policy Purpose

This policy is intended to guide ethical and responsible business behavior by defining standards of conduct expected from all participants at Oregon HFMA events.

Procedure

Conflict of Interest:

- ◆ HFMA member entering into contractual arrangements with vendor/supplier/individual with whom member has a personal interest or relationship.
- ◆ Should such situations exist, member must disclose and obtain Board approval before committing the chapter. Member with conflict **can not** sign for chapter.

Observance of HFMA Policies

- ◆ Oregon HFMA will be compliant with all laws and National HFMA requirements affecting its operations.

Code of Conduct

- ◆ Presentations intended for membership and related attendees must be appropriate for the audience
 - Lewd and/or unprofessional behavior is not appropriate
 - Presenter should be considerate of all audience participants
- ◆ Lewd and unprofessional conduct at Oregon HFMA events will not be tolerated. Continued demonstration of such behavior may result in attendance limitations.
