



STUDENT REDUCED REGISTRATION FEE POLICY

(Approved by board October 31, 2014)

Policy Purpose

The chapter recognizes the importance of reaching out to student members, letting them know what HFMA has to offer, providing education and networking opportunities to assist them in their career path, and thereby establishing a pool of potential future regular attendees and members. The chapter also recognizes that, as students, these members often have limited funds and do not have an employer to support paying meeting registration fees.

The chapter will therefore allow students to attend chapter meetings for a registration fee of \$50.

Procedure

- Student must be a current Oregon Chapter student member, not currently employed by a healthcare related employer
- Prior to the close of online registration, student must notify the chapter President or President-Elect of his/her interest in attending the upcoming meeting and desire to utilize the discount.
- President or President-Elect will verify student membership either online or through the Membership committee.
- Upon approval, the chapter's Cvent registration manager will provide a discount code to use when registering for the meeting.

HFMA Guidelines

- Chapter President, President-Elect, or delegate shall report the number of student discounts per meeting to the Board.
- The Board will have the option at any time to suspend or remove this policy at its discretion at any point on a prospective basis.
